

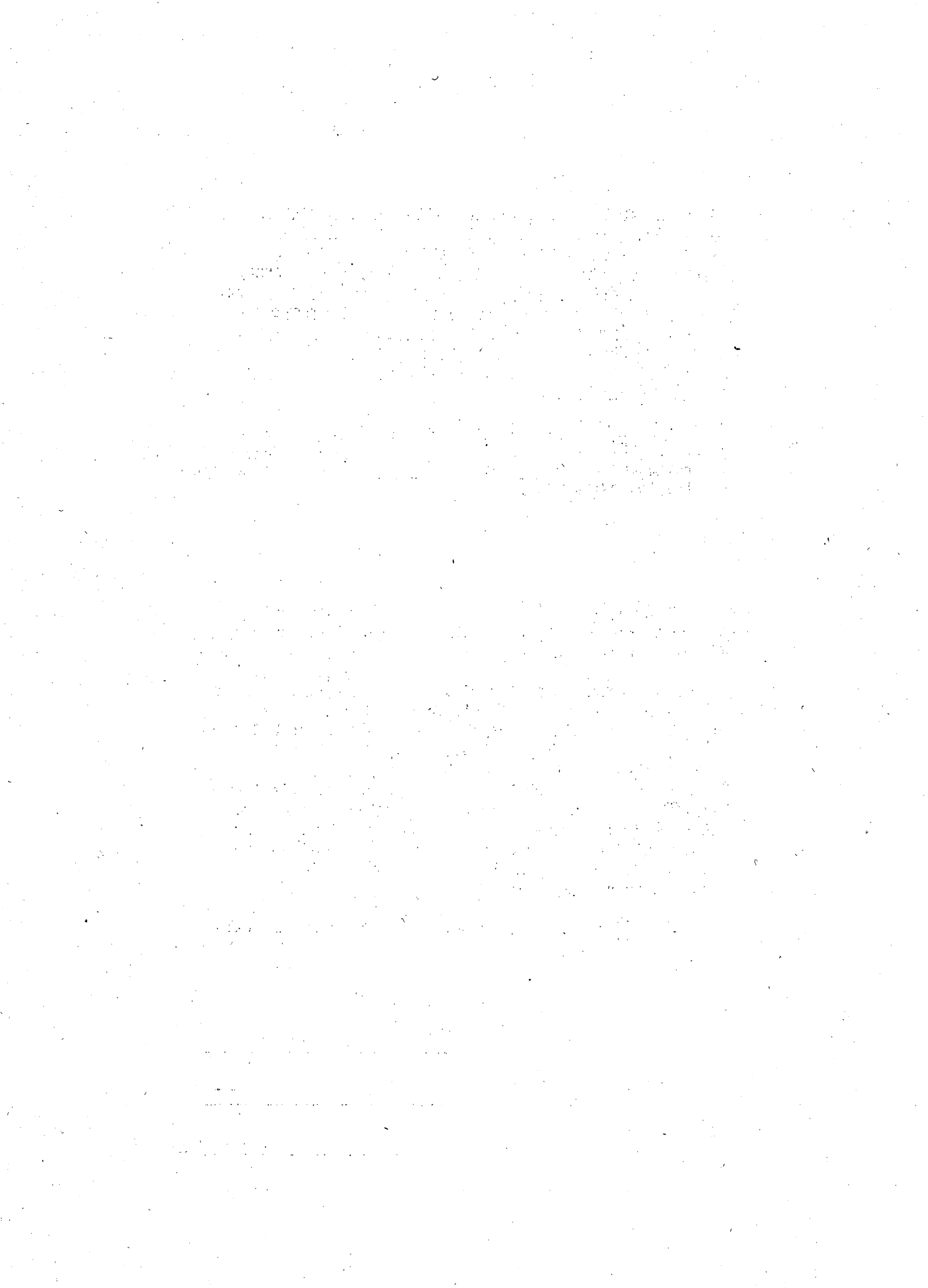
AGREEMENT TO INDEMNIFY THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS AGAINST DAMAGES THAT MAY BE INCURRED BY WORK TO BE PERFORMED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS UNDER AUTHORITY OF CHAPTER 91 OF THE GENERAL LAWS AS AMENDED BY CHAPTERS 516 AND 524, ACTS OF 1950, PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT, DEVELOPMENT, MAINTENANCE AND PROTECTION OF TIDAL AND NON-TIDAL RIVERS AND STREAMS, HARBORS, TIDE-WATERS, FORESHORES AND SHORES ALONG A PUBLIC BEACH OUTSIDE OF BOSTON HARBOR, INCLUDING THE MERRIMACK AND CONNECTICUT RIVERS.

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, by the Department of Public Works, proposes to carry out under the provisions of Section 11 of Chapter 91 of the General Laws the following work:

WHEREAS, the carrying out of said work may cause damage to property by the taking of land or of any right, interest or easement therein;

NOW, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE ABOVE PREMISES, we, the undersigned, Selectmen of said Town, all duly chosen, qualified and acting under the provisions of section 29 of Chapter 91 of the General Laws, and under authority of a vote of the town at a meeting held on _____, an attested copy of which is attached, hereby stipulate and agree in behalf of said town to indemnify and save harmless said Commonwealth, its representatives and agents against all claims and demands for damages that may be sustained by any person whose land or any rights or interest therein is taken for or is injured by said work.

DRAFT OF ARTICLE FOR THE TOWN WARRANT

ARTICLE To see if the Town will assume liability in the manner provided by section 29 of Chapter 91 of the General Laws, as amended by Chapters 516 and 524, Acts of 1950, for all damages that may be incurred by work to be performed by the Department of Public Works of Massachusetts for the improvement, development, maintenance and protection of tidal and non-tidal rivers and streams, harbors, tidewaters, foreshores and shores along a public beach outside of Boston Harbor, including the Merrimack and Connecticut Rivers, in accordance with Section 11 of Chapter 91 of the General Laws, and authorize the Selectmen to execute and deliver a bond of indemnity therefor to the Commonwealth.

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Public Works, acting under the provisions of Chapter 91 of the General Laws as amended by Chapters 516 and 524, Acts of 1950, will give a public hearing on Monday, February 26, 1951, at 10 o'clock a.m. in the Hearing Room on the fourth floor of the Public Works Building at 100 Nashua Street, Boston to all parties interested in petitions for the improvement, development, maintenance and protection of tidal and non-tidal rivers and streams, harbors, tidewaters, foreshores and shores along a public beach outside of Boston Harbor, including the Merrimack and Connecticut Rivers.

The provisions of the appropriation available for this work require contributions from the municipality, organizations or individuals amounting to one-half of the cost of each project, and the Department requires the municipality to assume, by town vote, under the provisions of Section 29 of Chapter 91, liability for damages that may be incurred by the work. Petitions should be filed with the Department not later than February 19, 1951. It is requested that petitions for all desired projects be filed even though such projects have been presented previously.


