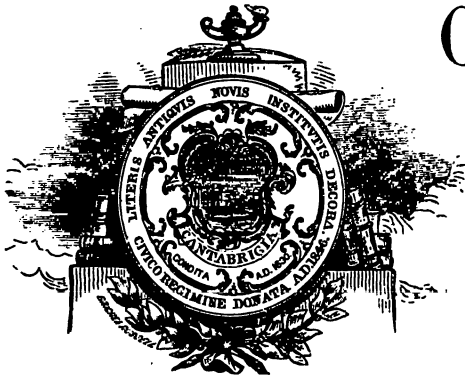




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Chestnut Street -

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *forty feet* in width between

Magazine and Pearl Streets

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

E. F. Bowker
dated January 6. 1874.

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken ~~as aforesaid~~ *and* that *thirty days* be allowed for the removal of fences or other obstructions standing on the land so taken as aforesaid,
