In response to Awaiting Report #24 regarding the opportunity for developing affordable housing between First and Second Streets in East Cambridge, the Community Development Department is currently preparing a plan and rezoning proposal that includes this site as part of the East Cambridge Interim Planning Overlay District (IPOD).

The Community Development Department has been working with the East Cambridge Rezoning Advisory Committee, a group made up of residents and business representatives. A major goal for the area is the creation of new opportunities for housing and particularly affordable housing. Within the next three months, the Planning Board is expected to submit to City Council a rezoning amendment designed to achieve goals endorsed by the advisory committee.
