WHEREAS:

Warren Sheehan, a former employee of the Veterans' Benefits Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the City of Cambridge on June 1, 1931 and was pensioned on October 18, 1958 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 77, of the General Laws and died on April 23, 1975, having served not less than twenty-seven years, and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Gladys E. Sheehan, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That, under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 101 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Warren Sheehan, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Gladys E. Sheehan, widow of Warren Sheehan, of \$1,680.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.
