- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of late retired Cambridge Police Officer Thomas J. Mills; and
- WHEREAS: Officer Mills, the senior patrol officer within the Department prior to his retirement, was first appointed to the Department on September 16, 1956, having previously served as a member of the Cambridge Fire Department; and
- WHEREAS: Prior to Officer Mills' retirement, his last route assignment covered the Porter Square/Massachusetts Avenue area known as Porter Square 19; and
- WHEREAS: While holding this assignment daily, Officer Mills would cross schoolchildren at the corner of Beech Street and Massachusetts Avenue, befriending these children, while making them aware of good public safety habits; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of Officer Mills at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record naming the corner of Beech Street and Massachusetts Avenue as the Officer Thomas J. Mills Square, in memory of this thirty-three year veteran of the Cambridge Police Department; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to confer with the Commissioner of Public Works to arrange for a suitable dedication ceremony; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family on behalf of the entire City Council.
