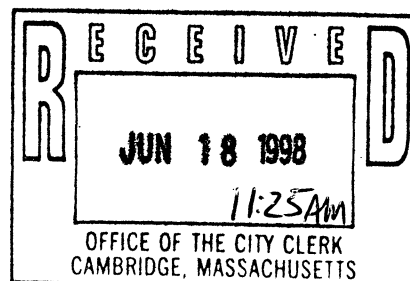

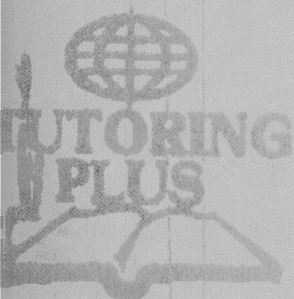

Tutoring Plus is a 34 year-old nonprofit agency located in the Area IV neighborhood of Cambridge, Massachusetts. Our mission is to encourage and support the academic, social, and personal growth of youth, primarily of Area IV, through the use of volunteer tutors and other community resources. Our two initiatives, the One-on-One program and the Neighborhood Homework Center, serve families of low to moderate income, many of which are either headed by a single-parent, or have recently immigrated from the West Indies of Latin America.

Over 130 volunteer shared their time, energy, and experience with 191 Tutoring Plus students in 1996-1997, contributing a total of 12,000 hours. Tutoring Plus recruits caring adults from all walks of life: community residents, bankers, engineers, teachers, physicians, and students drawn from local colleges and universities.

One-on-One, the largest of the agencies programs, matches volunteers with students who are in need of individualized, structured tutorials. In addition to working on homework and the mastery of basic skills, pairs are encouraged to engage in social activities together. This often leads to the development of a strong, personal bond. One-on-One volunteers are screened to ensure the safety of our students. They are required to meet with students for at least 3 hours weekly over the course of their one year commitment.

The Neighborhood Homework Center serves as a place in which neighborhood children and youth can drop in for additional homework assistance or study quietly with other children. The Homework Center operates Monday through Thursday from 5:30 PM to 8:00 PM at the Area IV Youth Center, which is located at 243 Harvard Street in Cambridge. It is staffed by volunteer tutors and a coordinator employed part-time by Tutoring Plus. The coordinator directs nightly activities and serves as a consistent contact for students, parents, and tutors. The center currently serves 15 to 20 students per night and 50 to 60 over the course of the school year. Neighborhood Homework Center volunteers choose one evening out of the week to attend, and stay with that same evening for the semester long commitment.

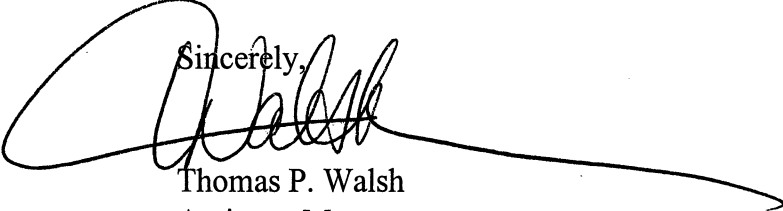
