An Ordinance Establishing the office of City Messenger

Be it ordained by the City Council of
the City of Cambridge as follows

Sec I There shall be annually chosen in the month
of January, by concurrent vote of both branches of
the city council, a messenger to the city council
who shall ^{hold} his office for one year, and until an
other is chosen in his place, subject to removal
at any time by the city council.

Sec II The said messenger shall have the general
care and ~~control~~ custody of the city hall, and
of the various apartments thereof. He shall
wait upon all committees and boards when in
session at the city hall, and in general, shall
perform all services required by the Mayor, by either
branch of the city council, or by such committees
or boards, and shall receive such compensation
as the city council may from time ^{to time} determine
