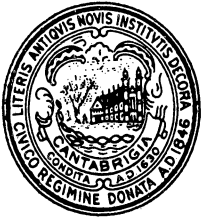
Subject City Council Communication #27 of June 25, 1984 - "Harvard Street and
Trowbridge Street Traffic Signals.

We have looked at this intersection and found that the trees have grown out over the street and obscured the view of drivers. The trees were trimmed and the size of the lights were changed from 8 inch to 12 inch lens thereby emitting a brighter light for the motorist to see.

We will check this again in the spring when the trees are in bloom to make sure we can see these lights.
