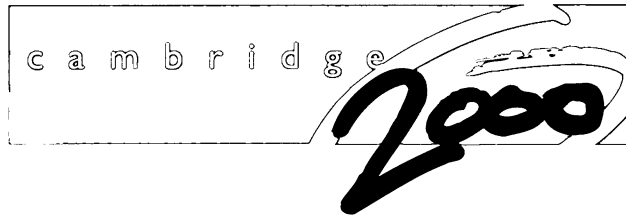

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$160,264.94 to the Public Investment Fund Community Development Department Extraordinary Expenditures Account.
