Public hearings have been held in twelve of the thirteen neighborhoods in Cambridge and have provided a good forum for all members of the community interested in Revenue Sharing and citizen participation, and

WHEREAS:

The culmination of these hearings will be a Revenue Sharing Citizen Participation Convention to be held on Saturday, April 6, 1974, and

WHEREAS:

The purpose of the convention is to further provide a sense of direction toward developing a citizens participation structure which will seriously focus on the ways in which the community can provide input into decisions effecting the allocations and expenditures of Revenue Sharing and other similar funds, therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to exclude Revenue Sharing Funds in the preparation of the 1974-1975 Budget for the City and to reserve these funds until such time as a Citizen Participation Structure is set up and recognized as the appropriate forum to determine the allocation of the City's Revenue Sharing Funds.
