To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting a transfer of \$6,000 from Reserve Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to the Public Celebrations Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to support the Cambridge Community Chorus. The Chorus recently presented a Centennial Concert of music by Samuel Coleridge-Taylor featuring *Hiawatha's Wedding Feast*. The Cambridge-Rindge & Latin School Vocal Ensemble joined in the concert. The Chorus supports a Choral Scholars program for four high school students chosen by audition. These students each receive \$100 and special vocal training and master classes in singing.

The annual performance of the *Messiah* is scheduled for December 12, 1998 at First Church Congregational at 11 Garden Street. The Chorus also sings each year at the Joyful Noise celebration of the birth of Martin Luther King, Jr. at the Cambridge Holocaust Commemoration.
