- WHEREAS: The invasion of Grenada is an act of war not sanctioned by the Congress; and
- WHEREAS: That invasion is thus a clear violation of the United States Constitution; and
- WHEREAS: The Claim of invasion to protect american lives is a false pretext; and
- WHEREAS: The Charter of the organization of eastern Caribbean states does not sanction armed intervention but calls for cooperation to prevent external aggression; and
- WHEREAS: The invasion will earn the enmity of millions of Latin Americans and strained relations between U.S. and its allies; and
- WHEREAS: Armed force is the worst way to deal with radical change which arises due to poverty and social justice; and
- WHEREAS: The invasion of Grenada has increased regional tension, increased the threat of global conflict, and has already cost the precious lives of American Marines and residents of the island; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council call upon the President of the United States and the Congress to order the immediate withdrawal of the invasion forces.
