WHEREAS: In the Minutes of the Area IV Crime Task Force Meeting for April 15, 1992, Police Sergeant Carlin is reported as indicating a fairly strong concern that some serious problems are raising their heads in the area of North Cambridge. It will benefit our work as City Councillors to be provided a lengthier and more specific itemization of what these problems are, how intense they are, whether the individuals who are involved therein are Cambridge and/or non-Cambridge residents and what preventive procedures have been initiated and will be in place momentarily to hold the situation in check and assure safety on the streets for our residents; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager request the Police Commissioner to provide response to the above raised questions within two (2) weeks.
