We write to you to ask that you do everything in your power to block the establishment of a Wendy's Restaurant franchise in the Central Square Area.

The Central Square area is already saturated with fast food establishments. There's even plenty of competition within the various types of food offered (e.g.-Burger King, McDonald's, Brigham's, etc.). Fast Food franchises can outbid the traditional commercial operations that have served the people of the adjoining neighborhoods for years. Increasingly, residents are abandoning Central Square as a focus for their regular shopping because of the exodus of these traditional operations (e.g.- Almy's, Corcoran's, and Cummings).

Fast Food establishments heavily contribute to the traffic and parking nightmare that is now overwhelming Central Square. Double and triple parking in front of these places is not uncommon.

Our neighborhood, and this city, cannot wait for the Central Square Action Plan to propose permanent remedies. By that time, Wendy's will be in place. Thank you for your help on this matter.
