- 2) Jackson Place

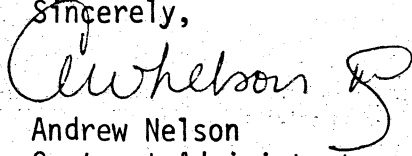
Also, we ask that these driveways be designated as private ways within the City of Cambridge.

WHEREAS, the residents of Jefferson Park desire to enjoy the same convenience in sending and receiving mail as is afforded other residents of the City of Cambridge;

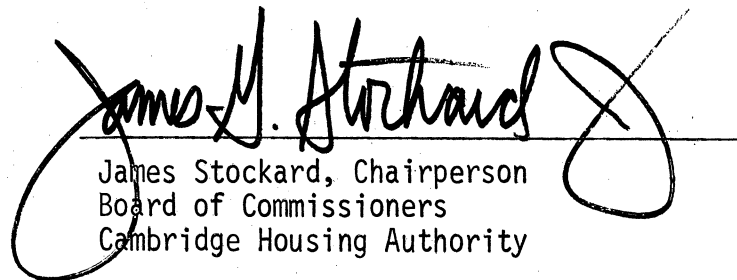
WHEREAS, the Cambridge Housing Authority has undertaken the substantial redevelopment of the Jefferson Park housing development;
