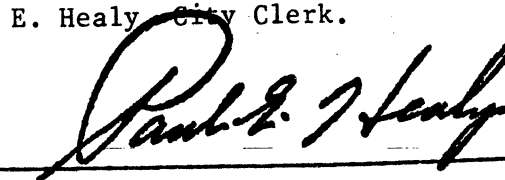

Ladies and Gentlemen;

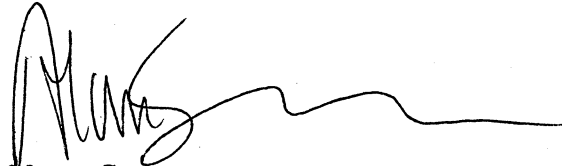
