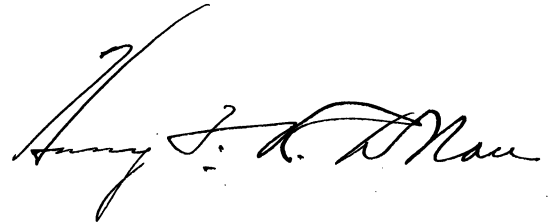

ORDERED:

That His Honor the Mayor be and hereby is authorized, in the name of and in behalf of the City of Cambridge, to sell and convey to Melville W. Webb for a sum not less than One Hundred (100) Dollars a parcel of City owned land situated as follows:-

Beginning at a point in the southwesterly line of Hastings Street, at its intersection with the northwesterly line of Burleigh Street, thence southwesterly along the said northwesterly line of Burleigh Street 63.5 feet more or less to land of now or formerly Alexander Cotton, thence northwesterly by land of now or formerly Alexander Cotton 6 feet more or less to a corner at land of Joe L. Hermanson et al, Trustees, thence northeasterly along land of Joe L. Hermanson et al, Trustees 63.6 feet more or less to a corner at the southwesterly line of Hastings Street, thence southeasterly along the southwesterly line of Hastings Street 6.15 feet more or less to the northwesterly line of Burleigh Street at the point of beginning.
