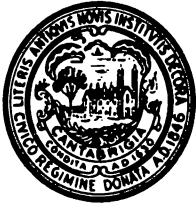

To The Honorable, The City Council:

As the City Council is aware, the City has embarked on a significant effort to develop a comprehensive transportation management plan for submission to the Department of Environmental Protection as an amendment to the State Implementation Plan of the Clean Air Act. This Transportation Management Plan will be the result of at least six months professional and internal preparation.

Such a comprehensive effort is not without significant costs.

In order to fund this effort it will be necessary to appropriate \$147,500.00 dollars from the parking fund to the professional technical services of the Law Department.

Passage of this recommendation is essential.
