Granite State Paging Inc., ("Granite State"), a New Hampshire corporation which provides paging services in Middlesex, Essex, and Suffolk Counties, and Arch Connecticut Valley, Inc., ("Arch"), a Massachusetts corporation, have filed a joint application requesting approval by the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") for the transfer of the certificate of public convenience and necessity ("certificate") held by Granite State, including all facilities and assets, and the transfer of control of Granite State to Arch.

This investigation is officially captioned:

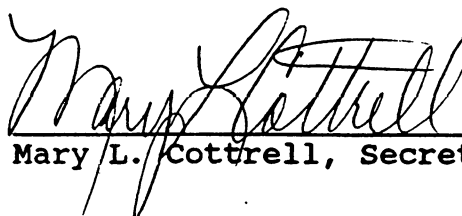
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Petition of Granite State Paging, Inc., and Arch Connecticut Valley, Inc., for approval to transfer ownership of facilities covered by a certificate as a radio utility from Granite State Paging, Inc., to Arch Connecticut Valley, Inc.

Comments, objections and requests for a public hearing on the proposed service must be made in writing with specific reasons for requesting a public hearing, and filed with the Secretary of the Department on or before March 29, 1993.

The petitioners, Granite State and Arch, are required to give notice by publication hereof once, in the Boston Globe, the Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and the Worcester Telegram, and to serve a copy hereof at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date [March 25, 1993], on the attached list, and to make return of service and publication no later than March 18, 1993.
