The Department has incurred the following costs for repair and replacement of sidewalk and curb at this location following the uprooting of the 24-inch Elm on April 8, 1982:

Emergency removal work (labor and equipment)	\$ 860.00
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Sidewalk and curb repair and/or replacement	\$1300.00
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Total	\$2160.00
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Cost of 3.5" to 4" Caliper tree in place	\$ 600.00
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At this time the Department is in the process of negotiating a settlement with Cambridge Electric Light Co., under whose direction the contractor was working.
