In Board of Aldermen, Dec. 27, 1869.

Whereas it is adjudged by the Mayor and Aldermen that the public necessity and convenience require that a certain new street, sometimes called "Beacon Street", and leading from Main to Harvard Street, be laid out as a public street or way, therefore

Ordered, That said Beacon Street, so called, be and hereby is laid out and established as a public street or way, by the name of Bigelow Street, agreeably to a Plan thereof drawn by W. S. Barlow, bearing date of 1869, and now before this Board, to wit from Main to Harvard Street, the same to be forty feet in width, as delineated on said Plan.

Ordered, That no damages be awarded to the persons over whose land said Bigelow Street is laid out as aforesaid.
