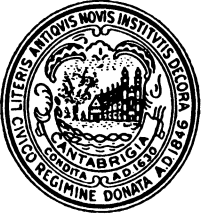

To: F-5 Parking Meter Maintenance \$3,500.00

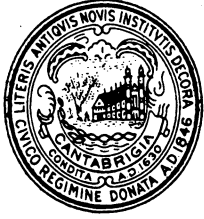
Same to be provided by appropriation from available funds in the Parking Fund.


