- WHEREAS:** After almost one year of intense surveillance by members of the Cambridge Police Department, they, together with police officers from North Providence, Rhode Island and a dozen FBI agents, participated in the arrest on July 6, 1990 of 4 Columbian nationals during "a buy bust" and seized in excess of 3 Kilos of cocaine whose estimated street value is three million dollars; and
- WHEREAS:** This successful undercover operation by Cambridge Police deserves attention and commendation because it is firmly believed that these arrests put a significant crimp in the flow of cocaine into the Harvard Square area. It would not happen without the competence, commitment, persistence and stick-to-itiveness of the following: Chief Anthony Paollilo; Lieutenant Richard Bongiorno, Commanding Officer of Youth/Narcotics Bureau; Sergeant Theodore Carlin; Detective Charles Linehan; Detective Richard Gardner; Detective Calvin Kanter, Jr.; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That this City Council expresses respect and appreciation to the above referenced Cambridge Police Personnel for a job well done in the titanic task of trying to decrease and ultimately interdict the scourge of drug-flow into this city; and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That the City Clerk be and is requested to prepare duly engrossed copies of this resolution and arrange with the Police Chief to invite all the referenced personnel come before this City Council at a regularly scheduled session, as soon as possible, to receive this resolution in person. Further, the City Clerk is requested to assure that a copy of this resolution will be placed in each member's personnel file at Police Headquarters.
