Re: Awaiting Report #30, \$114,000 Appropriation

Date: January 2, 1990

\$114,000 are the remaining balance in the Harvard Square Improvement Fund after the appropriation of \$40,000 for the improvement of City owned land at Massachusetts Avenue and Arrow Street near the Troika Restaurant. Under the provisions of the Harvard Square Overlay District (Chapter 11.544, Cambridge Zoning Ordinance), these funds may only be used for the following capital improvements within the Harvard Square Overlay District:

- a) provision of short term public parking;
- b) improvements to public parks or restoration of historic structures and monuments owned by public or nonprofit organizations;
- c) extension of surface improvements installed by the MBTA.

I recommend that the Capital Budget Committee consider proposals for the use of these funds in conjunction with the preparation of the 1992 Capital Budget, consistent with the criteria established for the Overlay District.
