Subject Historical Commission Ordinance

As I informed you last week, the Cambridge Historical Commission Ordinance as passed by the City Council on December 13, 1976, differs by the omission of one phrase from that submitted by the Commission in its Final Report on the Old Cambridge Historic District on June 16, 1976. To the best of my knowledge, there were no amendments offered to the proposed ordinance, and the difference seems to be unintentional. The Commission's initial version was also that advertised in the Chronicle on July 1, 1976.

The problem is the omission of the phrase "including one member from two nominees submitted by the Cambridge Historical Society" from the first sentence of Section 2-145. Nomination of two members by the local historical society is required under the General Laws, Chapter 40C, Section 4.

Annotated versions of the ordinance as submitted and as passed are attached.
