WHEREAS: The Brattle Film Foundation set an ambitious but critical goal of raising \$500,000 by the end of 2006 in order to ensure that the doors stay open and the screen stay lit; and

WHEREAS: Since the announcement, their base of donors from the community has grown from 250 to 1200, and have raised over \$400,000 dollars through individuals, businesses, foundations, and events; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record congratulating Ivy Moylan and Ned Hinkle for their hard work and dedication to preserving the Brattle Theatre; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Ivy Moylan and Ned Hinkle on behalf of the entire City Council.
