Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$27,316.00 in the Grant Fund from the Federal Emergency Management Administration (FEMA) through the United Way of Massachusetts Bay to the Human Services Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. The funds will be used to help public and private agencies increase emergency services to their clientele. Services include emergency food, which is provided through the Council on Aging and Committee of Elders sites; shelter, which is provided through the fund for housing (rent and mortgage assistance); and, other "necessities" such as fuel assistance, which is provided through the Fuel Assistance Program.
