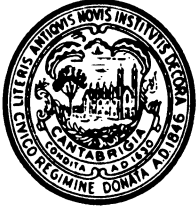

Charlesgate Yacht Club

Date: January 22, 1987

As part of the East Cambridge Roadway Improvement Project, unanimously approved by the City Council on April 24, 1978, Cambridge Parkway is to be narrowed by about 30 feet to create a grass park-like strip along the Charles River. This work will be completed this year and requires the removal of all parking on one side of Cambridge Parkway. In addition some parking will be removed from the other side at selected locations.

To compensate for this loss in parking, the Hotel Sonesta was required to provide 60 public parking spaces in their new garage. These spaces are now available and are located diagonally across the street from the Charlesgate Yacht Club. This arrangement provided more parking spaces at a convenient location than existed before the project began.
