- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (M.B.T.A.) is possibly considering the allocation of less money for the renovation of the Central Square train station; and
- WHEREAS: Many factors should be considered prior to any final decision by the T, not the least of which is the pending development of the Simplex site and the continuing effort by the Central Square Business Association to improve the condition of Central Square and to revitalize the business climate in the area; and
- WHEREAS: One of the major drawing points to Central Square is a clean, decent and modernized public transportation system; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the appropriate officials of the M.B.T.A. in order to determine exactly how much money will be allocated and to what extent renovations will occur at the Central Square station and to inform the T of Cambridge's efforts to improve the Central Square community.
