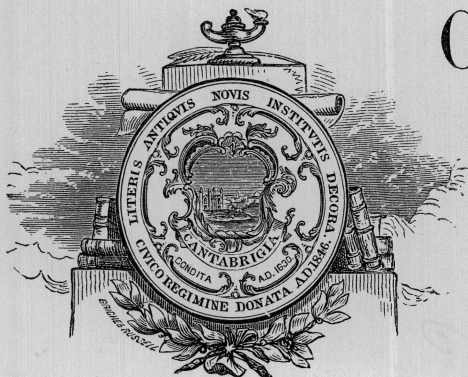

Charles Street
from Third St. to Fifth St.
should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *fifty feet*
in width between

Third St. and Fifth St.

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

J. G. Chase,

dated November 16, 1871,

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. *and*
that thirty days be allowed for the
removal of fences and other obstructions, now
standing on the land so taken as aforesaid.
