- WHEREAS: John had long been active in the corporal works of mercy; visiting the sick as he did almost daily at the Youville Hospital and feeding the hungry; by working on behalf of the many senior citizens who reside in Cambridge; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the entire Geary family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family on behalf of the entire City Council.
