To the Honorable, the City Council:


I take this occasion to report to your Honorable Body regarding the legality relating to the submission of a supplementary budget request emanating from the School Department.

I have discussed this matter with Mr. McCarthy, the Acting City Solicitor, and he advises me that supplementary requests meeting my approval and submitted and acted upon prior to the establishment of the tax rate are legal.

I should like to further advise your Honorable Body that I acted upon supplemental funds for the School Department as it relates to a pay increase in one instance and as it relates to satisfying obligated funds in the non-contributory pension account but I did not act to reduce a requested figure of \$150,000 in outages.

I trust that this satisfactorily explains the action taken by myself in these several significant fiscal areas.
