WHEREAS: The groundbreaking for St. Patrick's Place, a major public/private affordable housing endeavor by Just-A-Start, is December 10, 1991; and

WHEREAS: 32 units of housing, including 23 affordable units, will be created in the former site of St. Patrick's Church, the rectory, Croagh Patrick Hall, and an existing apartment building; and

WHEREAS: This project was made possible by the Archdiocese's willingness to sell the land significantly below its market value; and

WHEREAS: Financial assistance--essential for the success of the project--has been provided by East Cambridge Savings Bank, the Cambridge Affordable Housing Trust, the Cambridge Housing Development Fund, the Executive Office of Communities and Development, and the Massachusetts Government Land Bank; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council congratulates Just-A-Start and all parties who made this auspicious groundbreaking possible and wishes the project continued success; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to Just-A-Start on December 10, 1991.
