- WHEREAS: Head Start since its establishment on May 18, 1965 has provided comprehensive health, education, nutrition, and social services to close to eleven million pre-school children and their families; and
- WHEREAS: Programs such as Head Start have been proven to provide lasting positive effects on children; and
- WHEREAS: The week of May 13 has been designated as Head Start Week and the Cambridge Head Start will join more than nine thousand Head Start centers across the country to celebrate the twenty-fifth anniversary of the programs; therefore
- RESOLVED: That this City Council do hereby proclaim the week of May 13th, 1990 HEAD START WEEK in Cambridge and urges all residents to take part in the various celebratory activities; and be it further;
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk is hereby requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to the Cambridge Head Start office in honor of their continued work for the Cambridge community.
