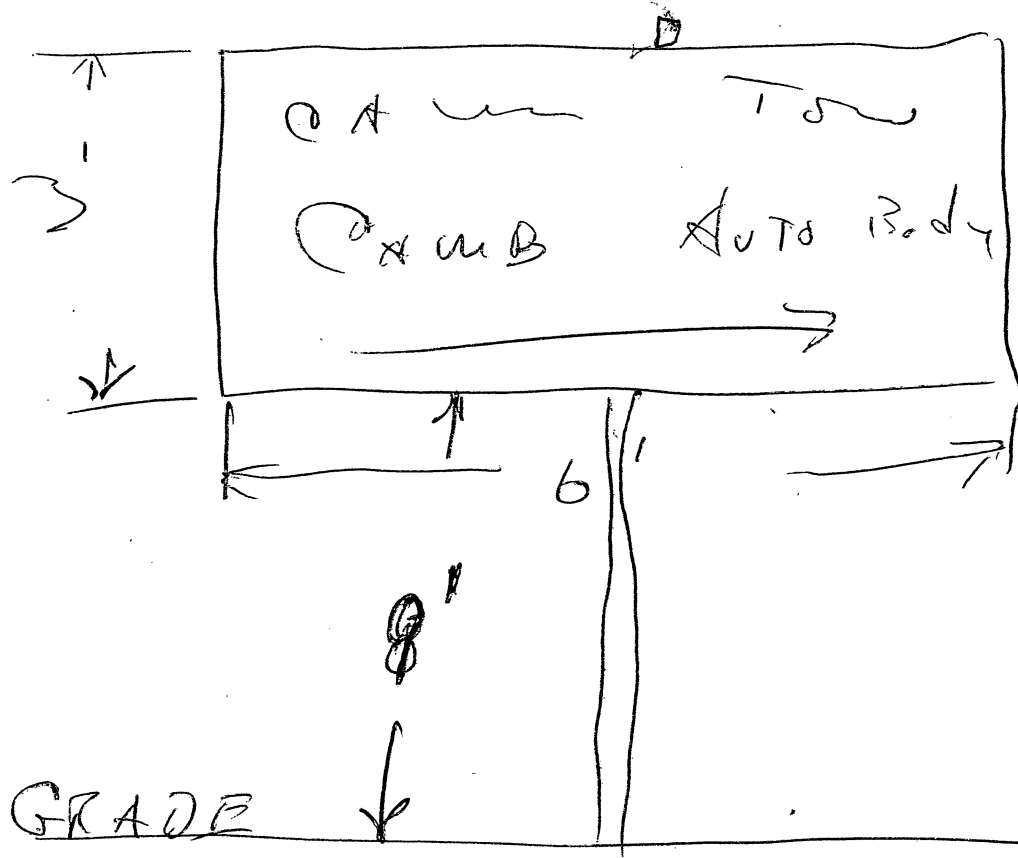

- ORDERED: That the Cambridge Tow & Cambridge Auto Body be and hereby is authorized to erect a sign at the corner of Smith Place and Concord Avenue on the ground next to the light pole three feet by six feet and nine feet above the curb level; said sign to be plain black and white with the words Cambridge Tow & Cambridge Auto Body and an arrow pointing down Smith Place; the erection and maintenance of said sign to be at the expense of the petitioner; and be it further
- ORDERED: That before erecting the above named sign the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said sign.

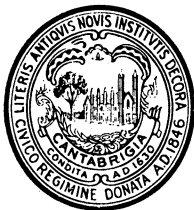

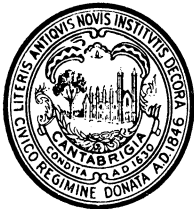
