

To the Honorable, the City Council:

It is respectfully requested that your Honorable Body give favorable consideration to an additional appropriation of \$100,000 to the Capital Improvements Account, said sum to be provided by appropriation from available funds in the Reimbursement Received for Appropriation to Capital Improvements Account.

Your Honorable Body may recall that in 1971 Harvard University made a total commitment to the City of Cambridge of \$200,000 to be used for recreation and related projects in the Riverside area, \$100,000 of which was to be used for the renovation of Corporal Burns Playground. This sum of money, when received, was deposited to the Reimbursement Received for Appropriation to Capital Improvements Account while payments for the work involved were actually made from the Capital Improvements Account. In order to reimburse the Capital Improvements Account, it is therefore necessary that the enclosed order be adopted by your Honorable Body.
