S. Army, The Federal Bureau of Investigation, Babson College and Northeastern University; and
- WHEREAS: Jim's conduct and professionalism has set an example of dedication, determination and commitment for all young police officers to emulate, so much so that he has inspired his two sons, James Jr. and Paul to become police officers; now therefore be it
