

City of Cambridge.

In the year One Thousand Eight  
Hundred and Sixty-eight.

An Ordinance  
establishing the Salaries of certain  
offices, and for other purposes.

Be it ordained by the City Council  
of the City of Cambridge, as follows:

Section 1. The annual salaries of the  
several offices named in this  
section shall be as follows: -  
The Board of Assessors, thirty-six  
hundred dollars: - The Treasurer  
of the City and Collector of Taxes,  
while both offices are held by  
the same person, twenty-five  
hundred dollars: - The Chief of  
Police, fifteen hundred dollars: -  
The Superintendent of Streets and  
Drain, fifteen hundred dollars: -  
and the City Messenger, one  
thousand dollars: which sums  
shall be paid in equal quarterly  
payments, and shall be in full

for all services rendered in an  
official capacity.

Section 2. The foregoing sections shall  
take effect as of the first Monday  
of January last.

Section 3. There shall be paid  
the Assistant Assessors four dollars  
a day each, for every day's service  
rendered to the City in their  
official capacity.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts  
of ordinances in conflict with this  
one hereby repealed.
