Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of a grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for \$678,600.00 to the Community Development Extraordinary Expenditure Account to provide funds for the HOME Program which was established by the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 with the goal of increasing the supply of decent, safe, and affordable housing.
