NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

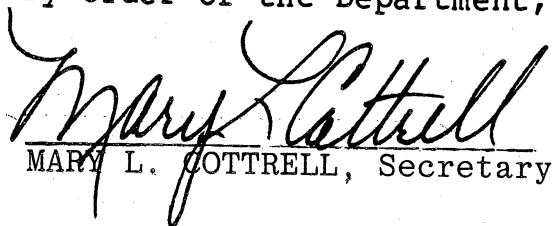
The Department of Public Utilities has reviewed and revised the proposed regulations set forth in two petitions filed by the Massachusetts Community Action Program Directors Association, the Community Teamwork, Inc. of Lowell, the Franklin Community Action Corporation, the North Shore Community Action Program, the People Acting in Community Endeavors, the Quincy Community Action Organization, the South Middlesex Opportunity Council and the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts requesting that the Department amend its existing regulations governing public notice of rate requests filed by regulated electric, gas, and telephone utilities and adopt new regulations which would require the use of newspaper publication of requested rate relief and public hearings. The Department has expanded the scope of the rulemaking to include regulated water utilities. A copy of the regulations proposed by the Department is available from: Secretary, Department of Public Utilities, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, MA 02202.

The Department will hold a public hearing on December 21, 1984, at 10:00 A.M. at the Department's offices, 100 Cambridge Street, 12th floor, Boston, Massachusetts, on the proposed regulations pursuant to G.L. c. 30A, §§2 and 4, and G.L. c. 159A, as amended, to determine whether the Department should adopt these regulations.

Oral presentation of data, views or arguments relating to the proposal may be submitted by any interested person at the public hearing.

All parties interested in submitting comments are asked to do so no later than 5:00 P.M., December 19, 1984, at the Department's offices, 100 Cambridge Street, 12th floor, Boston, Massachusetts.
