To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 00-94, regarding a report on the incident at 1100 Massachusetts Avenue, Police Commissioner Ronnie Watson reports the following:

The incident at 1100 Massachusetts Avenue was as a result of an investigation and arrest by the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) Task Force. A detective from the Cambridge Police Department's Special Investigation Unit is a member of the Task Force. Subsequent to the DEA's attempt to arrest the suspect, he fled to 1100 Mass Ave. The DEA asked for assistance. Both Cambridge Police and Mass State Police responded. Cambridge police officers effected the arrest. According to the DEA agent in charge at the scene, the only law enforcement personnel with shotguns were state police. The incident has been reported to Colonel DiFava of the State Police who has directed the initiation of an internal affairs investigation.
