WHEREAS: The unadulterated concept of Human Rights for people throughout the world remains the same from one generation to another; and

WHEREAS: On December 7, 1992, as Amnesty International U.S.A. marks Human Rights Day, people must be mindful of the changes in the world's map in recent years; and

WHEREAS: With termination of the Cold War and the establishment of democratically elected governments in Eastern Europe and Latin America, these societies have been struggling to devise a manner of accountability for the atrocities perpetrated by previous regimes; and

WHEREAS: Violent civil confrontations and unrest continue to claim thousands of innocent victims in regions of the former Soviet Union, Bosnia and here in the U.S.A.; and

WHEREAS: The December celebration will feature Mr. Art Spiegelman, acclaimed author of the two volume work Maus and editor of the comics-and-graphics magazine Raw; and

WHEREAS: The wide scope of both foreign and domestic violence and crime emphasizes the necessity for adherence to a single human rights standard; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That I, Kenneth E. Reeves, Mayor of the City of Cambridge and the Cambridge City Council do hereby proclaim December 7, 1992 as Amnesty International Day in the City of Cambridge, reaffirming human rights for all people and do encourage citizens to support the project of Amnesty International in championing the cause of Human Rights.
