METRONET/RADIO TELEPHONE SYSTEMS

MetroNet, Inc. and Radio Telephone Systems, Inc. have requested approval by the Department for the transfer of the certificates of public convenience and necessity held by MetroNet, Inc. to Radio Telephone Systems. Both MetroNet and RTS are certified radio utilities in Massachusetts, but RTS currently has no network in operation in Massachusetts.

The proposed transfer would be made pursuant to a purchase and sale agreement providing for the sale by MetroNet to RTS of the transferor's mobile radio utility system in Massachusetts.

Comments, objections and requests for a public hearing on the proposed transfer must be made in writing and filed with the Secretary of the Department on or before July 6, 1990.

The petitioners are required to give notice of this request by publication hereof once, no later than June 22, 1990 in the Boston Globe, The Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and The Evening Gazette (Worcester), and to serve a copy hereof no later than June 25, 1990 to the parties on the attached list
