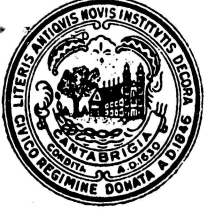

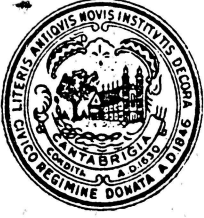

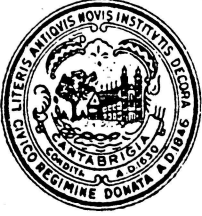

15.08.020 Work Completed by others.

Any person, firm, or corporation, other than electrical contractors or public service agencies, who employ one or more electricians permanently to do electrical work, may obtain a permit covering the work done by such permanent electricians for a period of time to be determined in each case. The fee for electrical work done under such a permit will be charged in the same manner as if separate permits had been given for each job.

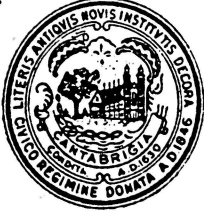
