That the City Council of the City of Cambridge, sitting as a committee of the whole, be appointed with the City Manager, the City Solicitor, the City Engineer and the Planning Board to confer with a representative from the Department of Public Works, State of Massachusetts, the Mayor of Somerville, the Somerville Board of Aldermen, the City Solicitor of Somerville, the City Engineer of Somerville and the Planning Board of Somerville relative to the advisability of taking the necessary steps to provide a six-lane traffic highway from the junction of Alewife Brook Parkway and the Concord Turnpike, over the roadbed of the Boston and Maine Railroad, to Lechmere Square, Cambridge.
