VICE MAYOR WOLF

- WHEREAS: The License Commission last week voted 2-1 to issue the certificate of occupancy to the Binney Street Garage without hearing from the citizen committee, appointed by the City Manager, which was to address the citizen concerns on public safety; and
- WHEREAS: This abrogation of a legitimate process which sometimes leads to successful mediation or, at least, alleviation of neighborhood concerns; and
- WHEREAS: The traffic consultants report has recommended some mitigation measures, related to public safety, the feasibility of which should have been determined prior to the granting of an occupancy permit; now therefore for be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager transmit to the License Commission the City Council's strong disapproval of the abrogation of the citizen process that was not supposed to be just for show and of its lack of serious consideration of the traffic report; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to study the traffic report and to continue involving the Community Committee in assessing its implications and report back to the City Council.
