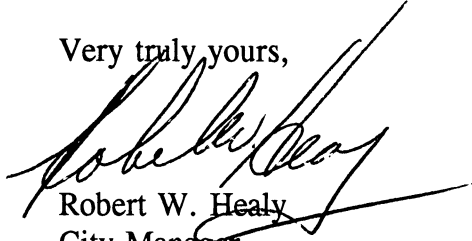

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$6,241.47 in the Public Investment Fund of the Community Development Department's Extraordinary Expenditure Account from HOME Program Income. As a major element of the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, the HOME Investment Partnership Act, i.e. the HOME Program, was established to provide financial assistance to help states and municipalities expand their supply of decent, safe and affordable housing. The expenditure of these funds will be administered by the Community Development Department which will base its selection of projects on the City's Consolidation Plan, approved annually by HUD. The affordable housing units to be developed may include acquisition, moderate rehabilitation, substantial rehabilitation or new construction for very low and low income families and for individuals who require social service support.
