- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Robert Flynn, late Cambridge Police Officer and life long Cantabrigian; and
- WHEREAS: Bob attended local public schools, including Rindge Technical High School and later served his country during World War II as a member of the United States Marine Corps from 1943 to 1946 at which time he received his honorable discharge; and
- WHEREAS: Bob was appointed a permanent Police Officer on November 21, 1960 and held various patrol assignments, the last of which was the Porter Square/North Cambridge sector, where he was a familiar and friendly face, providing protection and assistance throughout the area; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Marie (Kelly) Flynn and the Flynn family at this time of such personal sorrow; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Flynn on behalf of the entire City Council.
