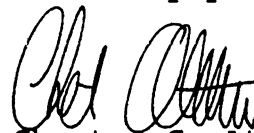
I would like to take this opportunity to personally invite you to several forums during the coming week to discuss recent events in the Persian Gulf.

Iraq's invasion of Kuwait in August showed blatant disregard for international law and the sovereignty of nations. The Bush Administration responded by unifying the world community, through the United Nations, in condemnation of Iraq's invasion and demanding that Saddam Hussein withdraw all his forces. This response has lead to the buildup of a huge multinational force in Saudi Arabia, which will eventually include 450,000 Americans. Considering the high stakes in this crisis and the real threat of war, many questions and concerns are on the minds of the American people.

I have heard from thousands of people in the 5th Congressional District expressing their concerns about the Persian Gulf crisis. I know this is a busy time of year, but I feel it is very important to hear your views and engage in an informative discussion with you and others on the role of the United States in the Persian Gulf.
