

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, Nov. 5, 1862.

Ordered,

That the City Clerk be directed to notify the Selectmen of Brighton that the "Great Bridge" over Charles River, between Cambridge and Brighton, has been rebuilt in pursuance of the provisions of Chapter 15 of the Acts of 1862, and that the City of Cambridge assumes the care and maintenance of so much of said Bridge and the draw thereof, as lies on the North Easterly side of the dividing line between said Cambridge and Brighton, as established by the second section of said Chapter, as also the most Northerly part of said Bridge, and the expense of raising the Cambridge half of the draw: and leaves to the Town of Brighton the care and maintenance of the remainder of said Bridge & draw & the Southerly part thereof & the expense of raising of the Southerly half of said draw.
